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# District Trends

## Fall 2005 to Fall 2008

### **Definitions**

Enrollment in this section is based on the credit and noncredit Full Term Reporting (FTR) definitions as follows:

#### FTR Criteria

FTR, Full Term Reporting, is a term used to indicate whether the student has met the minimum attendance requirements as either a credit or noncredit student as of term-end. The Chancellors office defines FTR credit and noncredit students as follows:

##### Credit FTR:

Student enrolled in at least one of the following:

- Weekly/daily census section
- Credit positive attendance section with 8 or more hours or .5 or more units earned.
- Credit independent study section with .5 or more units earned.

##### Noncredit FTR:

Student enrolled in noncredit positive attendance sections with 8 or more hours and did not enroll in a credit course. If a student meets one of the criteria to be a credit student, they are counted as such, and they are not counted as noncredit even if they enrolled in a noncredit course. This allows credit and noncredit enrollment at the district level to be added without double counting.

### **Enrollment Summary**

#### Gender

In fall 2008, the percentage of female credit students remained unchanged (53.1% in fall 2008). The biggest disparity was among Hispanic students where 58.2% were female and 41.8% were male. Among white students, 50.6% were female.

#### Age

The average age of credit students over the full term in fall 2008 was 27.7. The average age of students decreased by almost two years from fall 2006 (average age 29.4). After a 43% drop in the "Under 20" age group from fall 2005 (24.9%) to fall 2006 (14.2%), the enrollment for this age group increased to 25.9% in fall 2007 and increased again to 26.9% in fall 2008.

#### City of Origin

Approximately 29% of credit students in fall 2008 were from Santa Maria and 18.0% from Orcutt. Lompoc, with 17.1% of AHC students in fall 2008 has decreased slightly in the total contribution. The percentage of students from Nipomo has increased from 4.8% to 6.2% from fall 2005 to fall 2008.

#### Educational Goal

Approximately 34.4% of fall 2008 credit students indicated a goal to transfer – a slight decrease for the third year in a row. The percentage of students with a goal to earn a vocational degree or certificate remained about the same (5.7%, fall 2008) compared to fall 2007 (5.4%) after a decline from 7.7% in fall 2004.

## District Trends

### Fall 2005 to Fall 2008

#### Employment Expectations

The percentage of students who indicated that they expected to work full time (40+ hours per week) dropped slightly from 25.9% in fall 2007 to 23.4% in fall 2008.

#### Enrollment Status

In fall 2008, 43.4% of credit students were continuing at AHC, up slightly compared to fall 2007 (42.9%) after a two-year drop from 45.1% in fall 2005. Another 30.5% were returning (after at least an absence of one semester). Approximately 23% were first time students at AHC, with 8.0% having attended at another college.

#### Ethnicity

The fastest growing group by ethnicity has been Hispanic students who comprised 36.9% of the credit population in fall 2008. As a comparison, 26% of credit students were Hispanic in 1997.

#### Unit Load

The average unit load in fall 2008 increased slightly from the previous year at . The strongest growth in fall 2008 was among students taking between 12 and 14.9 units.

#### Majors

The top two majors in both fall 2007 and fall 2008 were Fire Control Technology and Business with about 4% of credit students indicating each of these majors.

#### Other Credit Student Characteristics

The percent of first-generation college students had slight downswing from 30.3% in fall 2006 to 28.6 in fall 2007 to 28.4% in fall 2008. The percentage of single parent students has declined 13% from fall 2005 to fall 2008. Re-entry students have declined 26% between fall 2005 and fall 2008 and learning disability students declined slightly from fall 2005 (2.5%) to fall 2008 (2.4%).

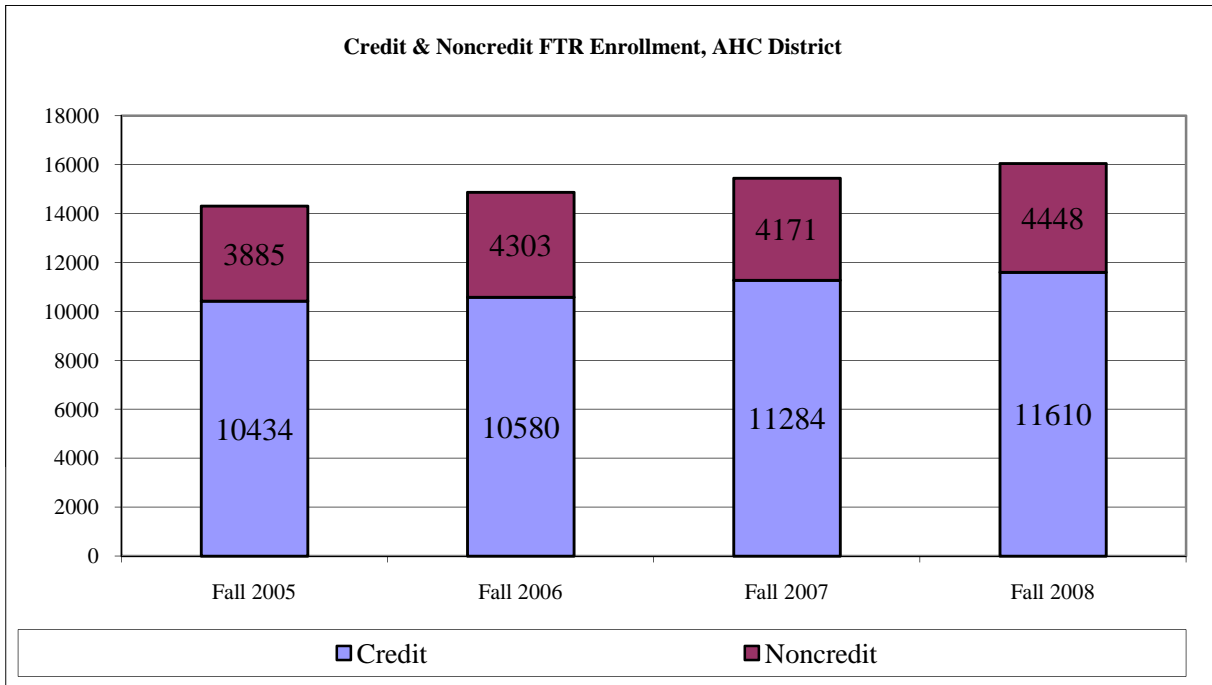
#### Noncredit Students

Noncredit students were older on average than credit students. In fall 2008 the average age of noncredit students was 51.5, with almost 44% age 55 and older. Approximately 74% were from the Santa Maria Valley. The number and percent of noncredit students from Lompoc remained roughly the same in fall 2008. The majority, 53.6%, of noncredit students was undecided or indicated no goal, though this number is down 10 percentage points compared to last year. Among noncredit students that indicated their ethnicity, 39% were white and 54% were Hispanic; fall 2006 was the first time in the history of AHC that more fall students indicated a Hispanic ethnicity than white ethnicity. The percent of students not indicating their ethnicity decreased slightly compared to the previous year and was about 36% in fall 2008. The gender distribution in noncredit was far more skewed with females totaling 66.9% of fall 2008 students.
