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District Trends Fall 2007 to Fall 2010

Definitions

Enrollment in this section is based on the credit and noncredit Full Term Reporting (FTR) definitions as follows:

FTR Criteria

FTR, Full Term Reporting, is a term used to indicate whether the student has met the minimum attendance requirements as either a credit or noncredit student as of term-end. The Chancellors office defines FTR credit and noncredit students as follows:

Credit FTR:

Student enrolled in at least one of the following:

- Weekly/daily census section
- Credit positive attendance section with 8 or more hours or .5 or more units earned.
- Credit independent study section with .5 or more units earned.

Noncredit FTR:

Student enrolled in noncredit positive attendance sections with 8 or more hours and did not enroll in a credit course. If a student meets one of the criteria to be a credit student, they are counted as such, and they are not counted as noncredit even if they enrolled in a noncredit course. This allows credit and noncredit enrollment at the district level to be added without double counting.

Enrollment Summary

Gender

In Fall 2010, the percentage of female credit students fell slightly compared to Fall 2009 (50.5% in Fall 2010 and 53.4% in Fall 2009). The biggest disparity was among Hispanic students where 60% were female and 40.1% were male. Among white students, 48.9% were female.

Age

The average age of credit students over the full term in Fall 2010 was 27.2. The average age of students decreased by almost a year and a half from the Fall 2007 average age of 28.5. The "Under 20" age group has remained steady the past three years with Fall 2008 at 26.9% and both Fall 2009 and 2010 at 26.6%.

City of Origin

Approximately 45.7% of credit students in Fall 2010 were from Santa Maria and Orcutt. Lompoc, with 16.9% of AHC students in Fall 2010 has decreased slightly in the total contribution. The percentage of students from Nipomo has increased from 5.9% to 6.5% from Fall 2007 to Fall 2010.

Educational Goal

Approximately 13.4% of Fall 2010 credit students indicated a goal to transfer – a decrease from prior years. The percentage of students with a goal to earn a vocational degree or certificate also dropped (2.4%, Fall 2010) compared to Fall 2009 (5.6%). * *Educational Goal was not captured accurately in 2010 which led to higher 'Unknown' counts than normal. This has been corrected moving forward and subsequent years should be correct.**

District Trends Fall 2007 to Fall 2010

Employment Expectations

This data is no longer captured in State MIS data and this item will not be reported on as of 2010

Enrollment Status

In Fall 2010, 45.9% of credit students were continuing at AHC, down from Fall 2009 (47.8%) but up compared to Fall 2007 (42.9%). Another 16.4% were returning (after at least an absence of one semester). Approximately 24% were first time students at AHC, with 11.5% having attended at another college.

Ethnicity

The fastest growing group by ethnicity has been Hispanic students who comprised 40.2% of the credit population in Fall 2010. As a comparison, 26% of credit students were Hispanic in 1997.

Unit Load

The average unit load in fall 2010 remained the same from the previous year with both at 8.0. The strongest growth in fall 2010 was among students taking between 0.1 and 2.9 units.

Majors

The top three majors in fall 2010 were Liberal Studies (teaching prep), Wildland & Fire Control Technology and Police Academy..

Other Credit Student Characteristics

Most of these variables are no longer captured in the State MIS data and this item will no longer be reported on as of 2010

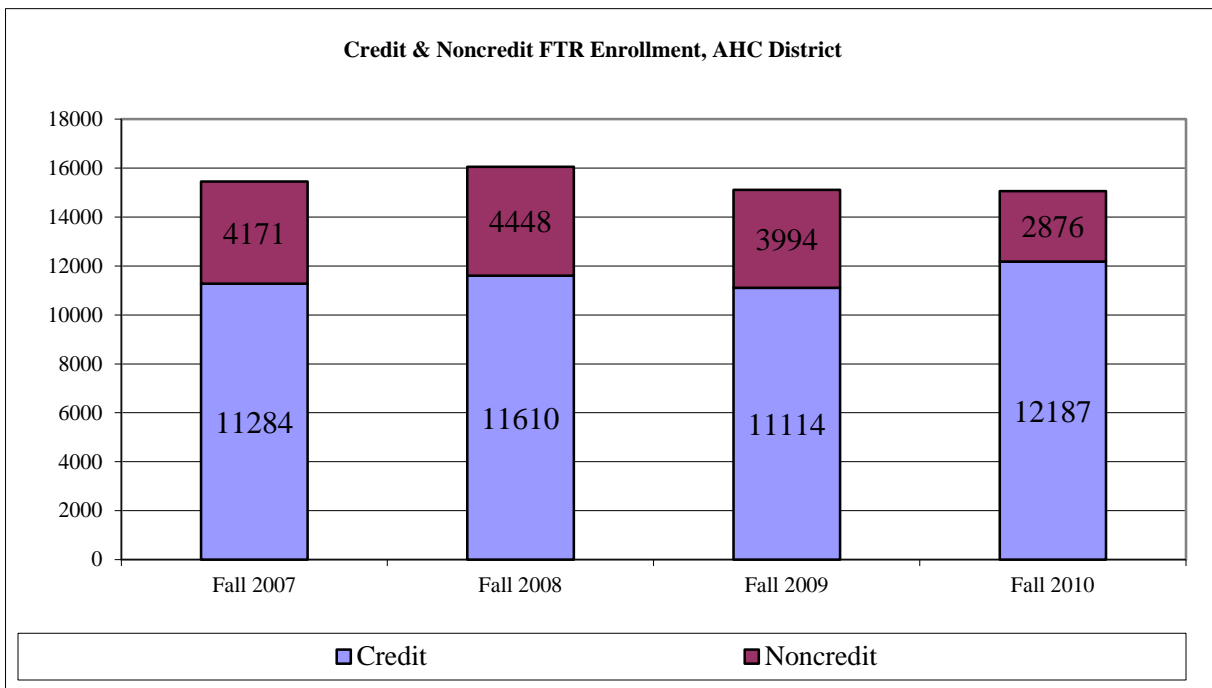
Noncredit Students

Noncredit students were older on average than credit students. In fall 2010 the average age of noncredit students was 48.6, with almost 50% age 55 and older. Approximately 74% were from the Santa Maria Valley. Among noncredit students that indicated their ethnicity, 28% were white and 45% were Hispanic. The percent of students not indicating their ethnicity decreased significantly compared to the previous year and was about 21.1% in fall 2010. The gender distribution in noncredit was far more skewed with females totaling 63.5% of fall 2010 students.
