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# District Trends Fall 2005 to Fall 2008

## **Definitions**

Enrollment in this section is based on the credit and noncredit Full Term Reporting (FTR) definitions as follows:

### FTR Criteria

FTR, Full Term Reporting, is a term used to indicate whether the student has met the minimum attendance requirements as either a credit or noncredit student as of term-end. The Chancellors office defines FTR credit and noncredit students as follows:

#### Credit FTR:

Student enrolled in at least one of the following:

- Weekly/daily census section
- Credit positive attendance section with 8 or more hours or .5 or more units earned.
- Credit independent study section with .5 or more units earned.

#### Noncredit FTR:

Student enrolled in noncredit positive attendance sections with 8 or more hours and did not enroll in a credit course. If a student meets one of the criteria to be a credit student, they are counted as such, and they are not counted as noncredit even if they enrolled in a noncredit course. This allows credit and noncredit enrollment at the district level to be added without double counting.

## **Enrollment Summary**

### Gender

In Fall 2011, the percentage of female credit students rose slightly compared to Fall 2010 (52.3% in Fall 2011 and 50.5% in Fall 2010).

### Age

The average age of credit students over the full term in Fall 2011 was 26.2. The average age of students decreased by almost a year and a half from the Fall 2008 average age of 27.7. The "Under 20" age group increased slightly in Fall 2011 to 28.3% after being under 27% the past three years with Fall 2008 at 26.9% and both Fall 2009 and 2010 at 26.6%.

### City of Origin

Approximately 47.1% of credit students in Fall 2011 were from Santa Maria and Orcutt. Lompoc, with 17.1% of AHC students in Fall 2011 has increased slightly in the total contribution. The percentage of students from Nipomo remained the same from Fall 2010 to Fall 2011.

### Educational Goal

Approximately 20.9% of Fall 2011 credit students indicated a goal to transfer – almost double from the previous year. \* \*Educational Goal was not captured accurately in Fall 2010 and Fall 2011 which led to higher 'Unknown' counts than normal. This has been corrected moving forward and subsequent years should be correct. \*\*

## District Trends Fall 2005 to Fall 2008

### Employment Expectations

### Enrollment Status

In Fall 2011, 60.0% of credit students were continuing at AHC, a large increase from Fall 2010 (45.9%). Another 15.9% were returning (after at least an absence of one semester). Approximately 16% were first time students at AHC, with 6.6% having attended at another college.

### Ethnicity

The fastest growing group by ethnicity has been Hispanic students who comprised 47.8% of the credit population in Fall 2011. As a comparison, 26% of credit students were Hispanic in 1997.

### Unit Load

The average unit load in Fall 2011 increased slightly from the previous years to 8.3. The strongest growth in fall 2010 was among students taking between 6 and 11.9 units.

### Majors

The top three majors in Fall 2011 were Liberal Studies (teaching prep), Registered Nursing and Pyscology.

### Other Credit Student Characteristics

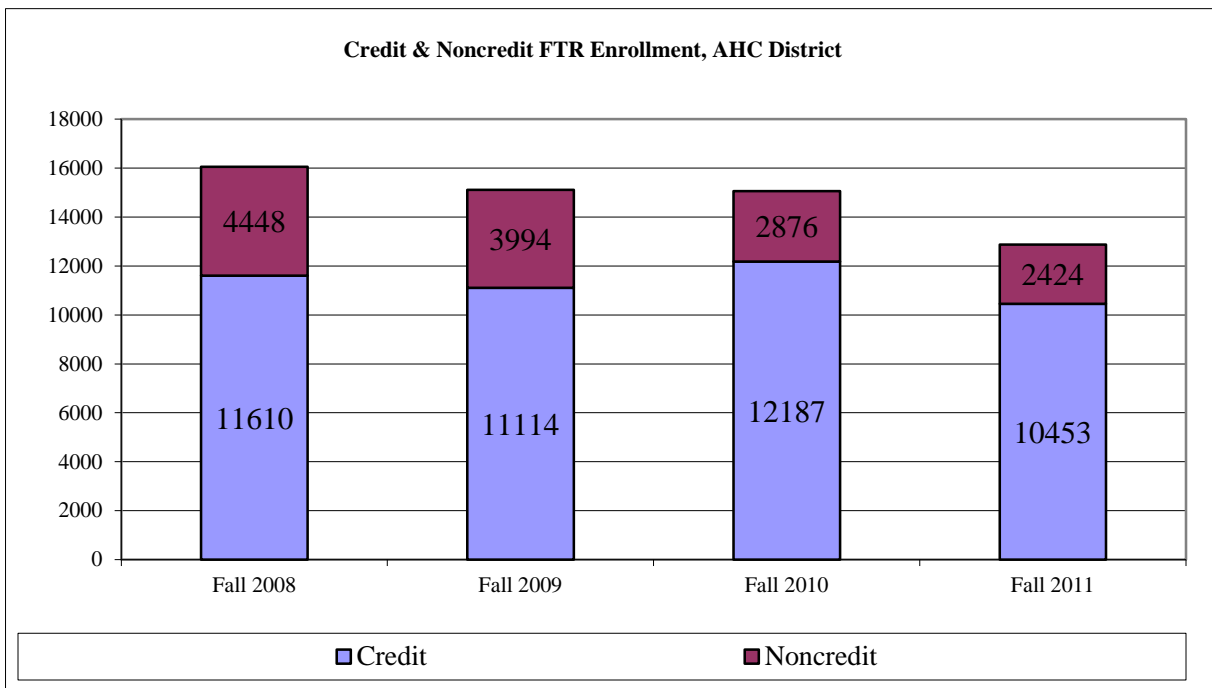
### Noncredit Students

Noncredit students were older on average than credit students. In Fall 2011 the average age of noncredit students was 49.1, with almost 40% age 55 and older. Approximately 75% were from the Santa Maria Valley. Among noncredit students that indicated their ethnicity, 30% were White and 50% were Hispanic. The percent of students not indicating their ethnicity decreased significantly compared to the previous year and was about 15% in Fall 2011. The gender distribution in noncredit was far more skewed with females totaling 63.3% of Fall 2011 students.
