<u>District Trends</u> Fall 2004 to Fall 2007

Definitions

Enrollment in this section is based on the credit and noncredit Full Term Reporting (FTR) definitions as follows:

FTR Criteria

FTR, Full Term Reporting, is a term used to indicate whether the student has met the minimum attendance requirements as either a credit or noncredit student as of term-end. The Chancellors office defines FTR credit and noncredit students as follows:

Credit FTR:

Student enrolled in at least one of the following:

- · Weekly/daily census section
- · Credit positive attendance section with 8 or more hours or .5 or more units earned.
- · Credit independent study section with .5 or more units earned.

Noncredit FTR:

Student enrolled in noncredit positive attendance sections with 8 or more hours and did not enroll in a credit course. If a student meets one of the criteria to be a credit student, they are counted as such, and they are not counted as noncredit even if they enrolled in a noncredit course. This allows credit and noncredit enrollment at the district level to be added without double counting.

Enrollment Summary

Gender

In fall 2007, the percentage of female credit students declined slightly for the second year in a row (53.2% in fall 2007) – down slightly from 54.4% in fall 2006, and 55.1% in fall 2005. The biggest disparity was among Hispanic students where 57.6% were female and 42.4% were male. Among white students, 51.0% were female.

Age

The average age of credit students over the full term in fall 2007 was 28.5. The average age of students decreased by almost one year from fall 2006 (average age 29.4). After a 43% drop in the "Under 20" age group from fall 2005 (24.9%) to fall 2006 (14.2%), the enrollment for this age group increased to 25.9% in fall 2007.

City of Origin

Approximately 28% of credit students in fall 2007 were from Santa Maria and 17.0% from Orcutt. Lompoc, with 18.1% of AHC students in fall 2007 has increased slightly in the total contribution. Students from outside of the local area increased from 5% to 7%.

Educational Goal

Approximately 34.7% of fall 2007 credit students indicated a goal to transfer – a slight decrease for the second year in a row. Students with a goal to earn a vocational degree or certificate continued to decline, from 7.7% in fall 2004 to 5.4% in fall 2007.

<u>District Trends</u> Fall 2004 to Fall 2007

Employment Expectations

The percentage of students who indicated that they expected to work full time remained between 25% and 26% from fall 2005 to fall 2007.

Enrollment Status

In fall 2007, 42.9% of credit students were continuing at AHC, down slightly for the second year in a row from 45.1% in fall 2005. Another 30.1% were returning (after at least an absence of one semester). Approximately 23.1% were first time students at AHC, with 8.6% having attended at another college.

Ethnicity

The fastest growing group by ethnicity has been Hispanic students who comprised 35.6% of the credit population in fall 2007. As a comparison, 26% of credit students were Hispanic in 1997.

Unit Load

The average unit load in fall 2007 remained about the same from the previous year at 7.3. The strongest growth in fall 2007 was among students taking between 3 and 5.9 units.

Majors

The top two majors in fall 2007 were Fire Control Technology and Business with about 5% of credit students indicating each of these majors.

Other Credit Student Characteristics

The percent of first-generation college students had a slight downswing from 30.3% in fall 2006 to 28.6% fall 2007. Single parent status data was not available for fall 2007; although, the percent of single parents enrolled has been between 8% and 9% for several years. Re-entry students have declined 26% between fall 2004 and fall 2007 and learning disability students were down 11% between fall 2004 and fall 2007.


Noncredit Students

Noncredit students were older on average than credit students. In fall 2006 the average age of noncredit students was 51.4, with almost 44% age 55 and older. Approximately 73% were from the Santa Maria Valley. The number and percent of noncredit students from Lompoc remained roughly the same in fall 2007. The majority, 63.1%, of noncredit students was undecided or indicated no goal. Among noncredit students that indicated their ethnicity, 45% were white and 48% were Hispanic; fall 2006 was the first time in the history of AHC that more fall students indicated a Hispanic ethnicity than white ethnicity. The percent of students not indicating their ethnicity increased slighly compared to the previous year and was about 44% in fall 2007. The gender distribution in noncredit was far more skewed with females totaling 67.5% of fall 2007 students.




AHC Fall Enrollment




